SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION OF THE SUICIDE PREVENTION PROGRAM MANAGER, THE SENIOR COMMANDER AND COMMUNITY HEALTH PROMOTION COORDINATOR DUTIES

- 1. REFERENCES.
- 1A. AR 600-63, ARMY HEALTH PROMOTION, DATED 7 MAY 2007, RAR 20 SEP 2009.
- 1B. DA PAM 600-24, HEALTH PROMOTION, RISK REDUCTION, AND SUICIDE PREVENTION, 24 NOV 2009.
- 2. AR 600-63, PARAGRAPHS 1-20, 1-21, 2-2(A), AND 2-3(A) WILL BE REVISED IN THE NEXT RAPID ACTION REVISION TO CLARIFY THE ROLES OF THE SENIOR COMMANDER AND/OR DESIGNEE WITH RESPECT TO THE COMMUNITY HEALTH PROMOTION COUNCIL (CHPC).
- 2A. SENIOR COMMANDERS, AS NOTED IN AR 600-63, PARAGRAPH 1-20(A), HAVE THE OVERALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR HEALTH PROMOTION, RISK REDUCTION, AND SUICIDE PREVENTION EFFORTS.
- 2B. SENIOR COMMANDERS SHOULD PRESIDE OVER THE COMMUNITY HEALTH PROMOTION COUNCIL, BUT MAY DESIGNATE, AS APPROPRIATE, THE GARRISON COMMANDER TO CHAIR THE CHPC. THE FUTURE RAR OF AR 600-63 WILL ALLOW THE SENIOR COMMANDER TO DESIGNATE EITHER THE GARRISON COMMANDER OR AN ALTERNATE INDIVIDUAL TO CHAIR THE CHPC.

- 3. THE FOLLOWING DUTIES REFLECTED IN AR 600-63, PARAGRAPH 1-25, (D THRU J) AND PARAGRAPH 1-26 (A THRU G) ONLY APPLY TO SUICIDE PREVENTION PROGRAM MANAGERS:
- 3A. ADMINISTERS THE SUICIDE PREVENTION PROGRAM FOR BOTH MILITARY AND CIVILIAN MEMBERS WITH A GOAL TO REDUCE SUICIDES.
- 3B. SERVES AS THE PRESIDING OFFICER OF THE SUICIDE PREVENTION TASK FORCE AND COORDINATES THE EFFORTS OF TASK FORCE MEMBERS.
- 3C. SERVES AS A MEMBER OF THE CHPC REPRESENTING SUICIDE PREVENTION ISSUES AND PROVIDING INPUT INTO RELATED PROGRAMS.
- 3D. TRACKS THE TRAINING OF ALL ACE-CERTIFIED PERSONNEL AND ACE TRAINING FOR THE INSTALLATION, STATE, AND REGIONAL SUPPORT COMMAND (RSC).
- 3E. SERVES AS THE POINT OF CONTACT FOR PROGRAM INFORMATION AND ADVICE TO THE COMMANDER AND TO MAJOR SUBORDINATE COMMANDS.
- 3F. INTEGRATES SUICIDE PREVENTION INTO COMMUNITY, FAMILY, AND SOLDIER SUPPORT PROGRAMS AS APPROPRIATE.
- 3G. COORDINATES WITH INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL ORGANIZATIONS TO SHARE INFORMATION, TRENDS, BEST PRACTICES, LESSONS LEARNED, AND TRAINING DEVELOPMENTS.
- 4. SUB-PARAGRAPHS 1-25 (D THRU J) WILL BE REMOVED IN THE NEXT RAPID ACTION REVISION OF AR 600-63.
- 5. SUICIDE PREVENTION PROGRAM MANAGERS SHOULD ALSO TRACK THE TRAINING FOR ALL SUICIDE INTERVENTION SKILLS-CERTIFIED PERSONNEL AND TRAINING FOR THE INSTALLATION, STATE, AND/OR RSC.
- 6. THE COMMUNITY HEALTH PROMOTION COORDINATOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR SERVING AS A LIAISON WITH THE COMMUNITY ON BEHALF OF THE INSTALLATION COMMANDER.
- 7. THE TERM INSTALLATION COMMANDER IN SUB-PARAGRAPH 2-3 (C AND C (1)) WILL BE CHANGED TO SENIOR COMMANDER IN THE NEXT RAPID ACTION REVISION OF AR 600-63.
